



## Canadian Occupational Performance Measure (COPM®): integration into the Outpatient Rehabilitation Stroke Pathway

Complete the COPM® with **all** patients or caregivers



COPM® is completed as part of the **initial** and **discharge** assessment process.

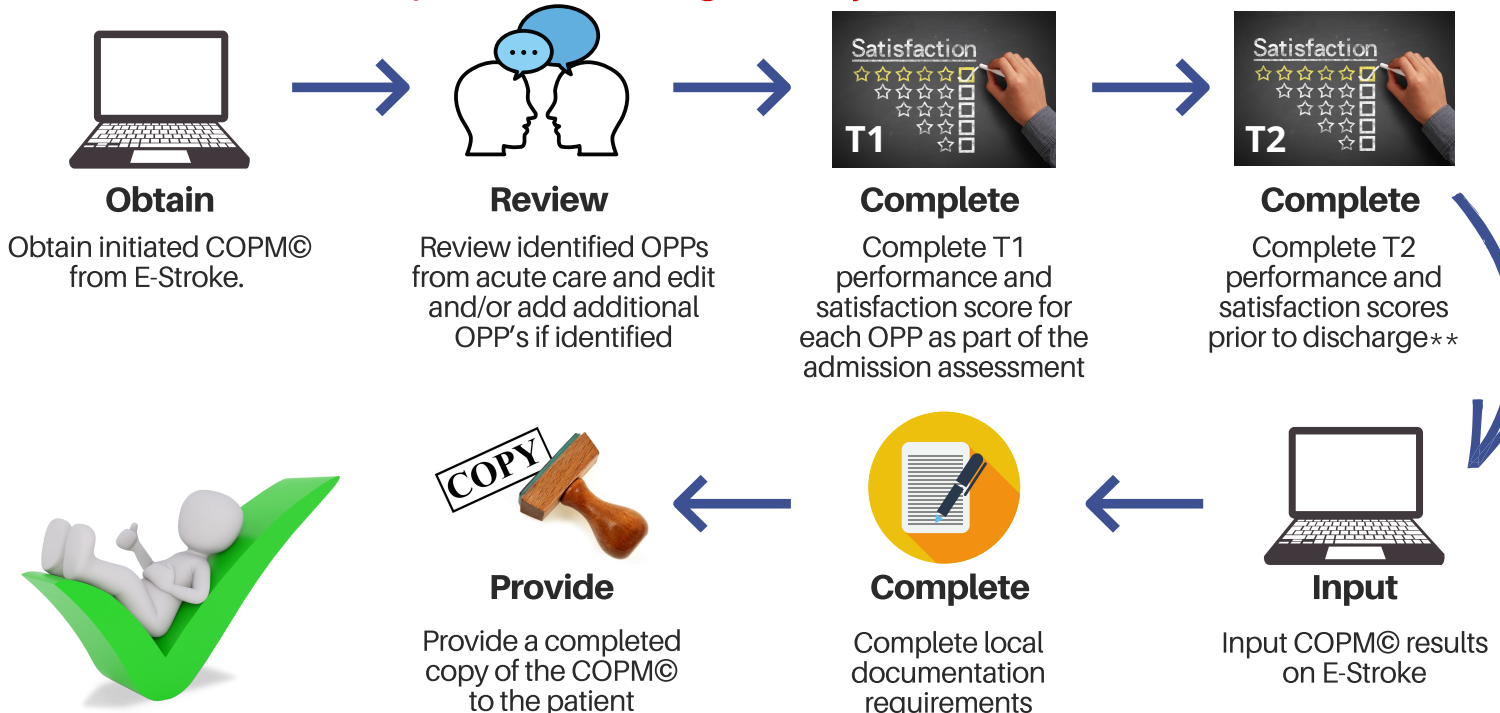
For patients with cognitive or communication impairments determine if the patient is able to participate in the discussion.  
 If they are unable...



Complete the COPM® with a caregiver/family member who knows the patient well

document the reason for being unable to complete the COPM® (e.g. translation services unavailable), <7days LOS)

### STEPS TO COMPLETE THE COPM® for patients coming directly from acute care



\*The E-Stroke copy of the COPM® has been approved by COPM® authors and can be included as part of the patient record.  
 \*\*Ensure the COPM® is completed by the same person (caregiver or patient) for the pre and post.
